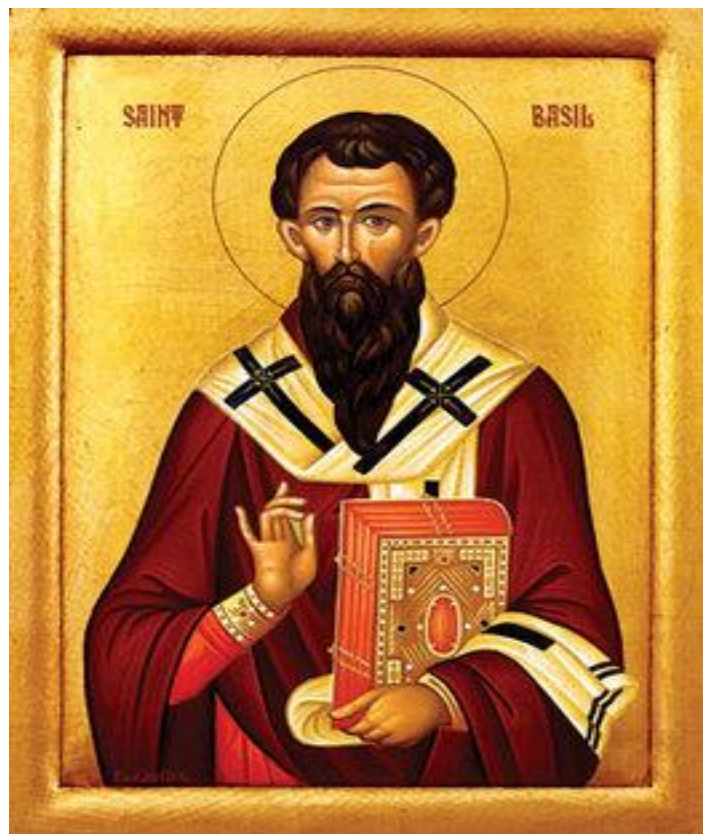

Kontakion 1

O chosen minister of the King of heaven and great hierarch of the Church of Christ, who shone forth throughout the whole world in the confession of the right Faith, and are possessed of great boldness before the Holy Trinity!
From all misfortunes shield us who cry out to you with compunction:

Rejoice, O Basil, great and holy hierarch, universal lamp of Orthodoxy!

Ikos 1

The Creator of angels, Who from the ages chose you beforehand to be a great luminary of His Church, O all-blessed father Basil, revealed you to be angelic in your manner of life; for having struggled in the wilderness with feats of asceticism and great contemplation of God, you hastened to the heights of virtue. Wherefore, O you who have acquired glory in the heavens, accept from us, the lowly ones who dare to praise you in these words of praise:

Rejoice, O Basil, namesake of kingship!

Rejoice, great hierarch of Christ!

Rejoice, unshakable pillar of the Church!

Rejoice, all-honorable scion of a holy family!

Rejoice, you from your youth served the King of Heaven with all diligence!

Rejoice, you with your friend Gregory the Theologian excelled in philosophy!

Kontakion 2

Seeing the Church of Christ assailed by the storm of the heresy of Arius, and submitting to the call of God, O venerable father, you came forth from the wilderness you loved, to the city of Caesaria, where you received the grace

Kontakion 3

Strengthened by the power of the Most High, O Holy Father Basil, you contended against Julian, the apostate from God, and beseeched the Lord and His all-Pure Mother to set at naught his plots against the Christians, that all might chant with thanksgiving: **Alleluia! (People sing Alleluia!)**

Ikos 3

Possessing great zeal for God Almighty, and taking His word in your hand as a sword, you swiftly cut down the tares of the pagan ungodliness of Julian, and made the faithful steadfast in piety. Teach us also, O venerable father, to serve the one God alone with a pure life, for we cry out to you thus:

Rejoice, you manfully denounced the prideful Julian for his apostasy from God!

Rejoice, you set at nothing his Christ-hating plots!

Rejoice, you wounded him with tearful prayer, as with a spear!

Rejoice, you announced beforehand his speedy destruction!

Rejoice, you freed the people of God from idolatry, like Moses did Israel!

Rejoice, you uprooted the tares of ungodliness!

Rejoice, you abundantly provided the faithful with the food of divine words!

Rejoice, you watered men's hearts with streams of grace!

Rejoice, you admonished us to hold fast the tablets of the commandments of Christ!

Rejoice, you with your manner of life confirmed the teaching of your mouth!

Rejoice, good and faithful servant!

Rejoice, diligent workman of the vineyard of Christ!

Rejoice, O Basil, great and holy hierarch, universal lamp of Orthodoxy!

Kontakion 4

By the power of the Spirit Who abode within you, O saint of God, you stilled the tempest of the rage of the Emperor Valens, who was stuck fast in the Arian heresy, and gave peace to the Holy Church; and in your holy labors and fervent supplications to God you chanted to Him, rejoicing:
Alleluia! (People sing Alleluia!)

Ikos 4

Hearing that you, O hierarch of God, stood firm in the Truth, and that all the faithful heeded your voice, the impious Valens desired to turn you away from the right Faith; and for this cause he sent to you his governor, Modestus, and later came himself to Caesaria. But you, O God-bearing

father, were undaunted by either the wrath of the emperor or the threats of dread general. And glorifying your steadfast confession, we cry out to you:

Rejoice, invincible champion of the right Faith!

Rejoice, shepherd who was ready to lay down your life for the faithful!

Rejoice, you showed forth the steadfast confession of Peter!

Rejoice, you manifested Elijah's zeal for the glory of the Holy Trinity!

Rejoice, you allayed the rage of the impious emperor with the divine magnificence of your sacred service!

Rejoice, you shut the mouth of the heretical general with your divinely wise words!

Rejoice, you were not daunted by threats of banishment and tortures!

Rejoice, for you even desired to receive death for Christ!

Rejoice, you endured persecution for the Faith!

Rejoice, you after many tribulations entered into the joy of the Lord!

Rejoice, you fearlessly proclaimed the Truth of Christ in the face of kings and rulers!

Rejoice, you by a steadfast confession showed yourself to be a faithful servant of the King of heaven!

Rejoice, O Basil, great and holy hierarch, universal lamp of Orthodoxy!

Kontakion 5

You were shown to be a divinely guided star, O Basil, holy hierarch of Christ, illumining the dark night of tribulations with the all-radiant beams of loving-kindness, dispelling the gloom of misfortunes, and pointing out the straight path to the kingdom of heaven to all who navigate the stormy sea of life, that rejoicing, they may all chant unto God Who saves: **Alleluia!**
(People sing Alleluia!)

Ikos 5

They who saw you to be a solicitous father, O holy hierarch of God, diligently sought help of you amid perils and sorrows; and you treated them all with loving-kindness, in yourself providing them with a model of true faith. O all-good father, be a speedy helper for us also, who are tempest tossed by sins and tribulations, but who cry out to you with love:

Rejoice, beacon of love shining forth from Christ!
Rejoice, you imitated the heavenly Father in loving-kindness!
Rejoice, rich treasure of those who have none!
Rejoice, sure refuge amid necessities!
Rejoice, you fed the starving, as did Joseph of old!
Rejoice, you in Caesarea found many hostels for the homeless and the poor!
Rejoice, you, like the Good Samaritan, bound up the sores of lepers with your own hands!
Rejoice, you healed the ailing Modestus, your persecutor, and saved him from being slain by the people!
Rejoice, you defended a poor widow from the malice of the governor!
Rejoice, you asked of God forgiveness of sins for a sinful woman!
Rejoice, father of orphans and consolation of the suffering!
Rejoice, you brought those perishing in sins to their senses and set them a right!

Rejoice, O Basil, great and holy hierarch, universal lamp of Orthodoxy!

Kontakion 6

You were shown to be a preacher of the Truth of Christ to the whole world, O holy hierarch father Basil, who pierces sinful hearts with the grace-filled power of your words, as with a sharp sword, and moves them to repentance, that all may chant to the Holy Trinity with a pure heart: **Alleluia! (People sing Alleluia!)**

Ikos 6

You shone forth in the firmament of the Church, O father Basil, like a great and radiant luminary enlightening the whole world with the understanding of the true Faith, and driving away the darkness of sinful passions, from which you also free us who cry out to you thus:

Rejoice, faithful servant of the Holy Trinity!
Rejoice, divinely illumined elucidator of the mysteries of the Faith!
Rejoice, you loudly proclaimed that the Son is consubstantial and the Spirit equally enthroned with the Father!
Rejoice, you made clear to the faithful the truth of the pre-eternal Light which shone forth from pre-eternal Light!
Rejoice, you confessed the Lord Savior to be God incarnate and the Creator of all the ages!

Rejoice, you disclosed the mystery of the two natures and one hypostasis in Christ God!
Rejoice, you with the kingly power of your words commanded the rich to throw open their granaries!

Kontakion 7

Intercede now for the Church at the altar on high, and be continually mindful also of us, who cry out to you with compunction:

Rejoice, hierarch of God, who received the abundant grace of the priesthood, as did Aaron!

Rejoice, wise performer of the mysteries of God!
Rejoice, you adorned well the rites of the Church!

Rejoice, man of prayer enlightened by the Spirit of God!
Rejoice, you, during the service, were illumined with a heavenly light, as some perceived!

Rejoice, you were surrounded by angels, as by certain all-radiant men!
Rejoice, for by your first prayer we prepare ourselves to partake of the
Mysteries of Christ!

Rejoice, for with your words on the evening of Pentecost we send up
our petitions on bended knee!

Rejoice, glory and adornment of the hierarchical throne of Caesaria!
Rejoice, for to the priests of the whole Church you impart from God
gracious strength in their ministry!

Rejoice, O Basil, great and holy hierarch, universal lamp of Orthodoxy!

Kontakion 8

An awesome and all glorious vision was revealed to the venerable Ephraim
the Syrian concerning you, O holy hierarch Basil, for one day God showed
you to him as a pillar of fire extending up to the heights of heaven; and later,
when he had come to Caesaria, the venerable one beheld you teaching with a
tongue of fire, and with compunction he cried out to God: **Alleluia! (People
sing Alleluia!)**

Ikos 8

You were wholly aflame with the heavenly light of seraphic love, O God-
bearing Basil; for your words were as bolts of lightning, burning up heresies,
but enlightening the souls of the faithful with flames of faith and love.

Wherefore, by your supplications, O father, grant that we may have if only
the least spark of your love, for we cry out such things as these:

Rejoice, pillar of fire reducing heresies to ashes!

Rejoice, warming fire of true faith and love unfeigned!

Rejoice, stern denouncer of the falsehood of the heresy of Arius!

Rejoice, ardent zealot of the Truth of Christ!

Rejoice, you put to shame the prideful Eunomius, who blasphemed
the Son of God!

Rejoice, you disputed the blasphemy of Macedonius against the Holy
Spirit!

Rejoice, you set at naught the vain belief of Nestorius!

Rejoice, earnest defender of the honor of the All-Holy Mother of God!

Rejoice, pastor illumined by the heavenly effulgence of love!

Rejoice, teacher of the Faith, who proclaimed words bearing
lightning!

Rejoice, divinely planted olive tree, which produced many saints of the Church!

Rejoice, vine which bore divinely wise champions of Orthodoxy.

Rejoice, O Basil, great and holy hierarch, universal lamp of Orthodoxy!

Kontakion 9

The whole assembly of the heretics was unable to withstand the power of the grace which abode within you, O holy father; for by the power of your prayer you wrested from the snares of the enemy a certain youth who had fallen under the authority of Satan, and returned him, penitent, to Christ, chanting with thanksgiving to God our Savior: **Alleluia! (People sing Alleluia!)**

Ikos 9

Many heretics who were conquered by your divinely inspired rhetoric and beheld the all-glorious miracle wrought upon the youth, united themselves to the Church, O holy hierarch Basil. Vouchsafe that we also may become faithful and obedient children thereof, who cry out to you thus:

Rejoice, you enlightened all the ends of the earth with heavenly doctrine!

Rejoice, you overcame the dark powers of hell with the grace of Christ!

Rejoice, you freed the youth from the snares of satan!

Rejoice, you nourished him with the Body and Blood of Christ!

Rejoice, for you did not let a soul redeemed by the blood of Christ perish!

Rejoice, for you beseeched Christ to forgive the young man who had fallen into pernicious sin!

Rejoice, for you amazed the people with this all-glorious wonder!

Rejoice, for by the conversion of the lost one you caused the angels to rejoice!

Rejoice, you bring deliverance from the assaults of the enemy!

Rejoice, speedy defender in time of temptations!

Rejoice, O Basil, great and holy hierarch, universal lamp of Orthodoxy!

Kontakion 10

Desiring to save His reason-endowed creatures, the Creator showed you to be a steadfast defender of the faithful, O father Basil, and a preserver of His Church, that through you the light of Orthodoxy might be revealed to the whole world, and all the faithful may chant with thanksgiving to the Holy Trinity: **Alleluia! (People sing Alleluia!)**

Ikos 10

You were shown to be a bulwark of the Church and a strong wall of defense for the faithful, O Basil great among hierarchs, when in the city of Nicea the doors of the church were opened by the power of your prayer, and you thereby revealed the Truth of the right Faith, and shut the mouths of those who blaspheme the name of Christ. For us who confess the Lord and Savior in Orthodox manner do open the doors of the loving-kindness of God by your aid, O father that we may cry out to you thus:

Rejoice, earthly angel, preserver of the Church of Christ!
Rejoice, defender of the faithful chosen beforehand by God!
Rejoice, you by your prayer opened the doors of the Church, as of old Elijah opened the heavens!
Rejoice, you returned to the faithful the holy church which had been confiscated by heretics!

Kontakion 11

Rejoice, you for the monks confirmed the rule of the perfect life!

Rejoice, you bequeathed rules, canons and the doctrines of salvation to be the heritage of the Church
Rejoice, you in your divinely wise writings bestowed a priceless treasure for the edification of Christians!

Kontakion 12

Christ God gave you great grace, O holy hierarch father Basil, not only to bring the lost to repentance, but to convert many infidels to Christ; for when you were already sick unto death, and drew near to your blessed end, you enlightened with holy baptism your Jewish doctor, his wife and children, and with them chanted the hymn of thanksgiving to the Holy Trinity: **Alleluia! Ikos 12

Prayer 1

O all-blessed father Basil, great among hierarchs, divinely wise teacher of the whole world! Great were the struggles and labors which you made for the glory of the Holy Church! You were a steadfast confessor and beacon of the Faith of Christ on earth, who illumined the faithful with the light of the knowledge of God, burned up false heresies, and announced tidings of the truth of salvation to all the world. And now, O you who has great boldness before the Holy Trinity in the heavens, help us who fall down before you with humility, to preserve the holy Orthodox Faith steadfast and unchanged until the end of our life, and keep us from being of little faith, from doubts and wavering, lest we be deluded by the words of soul-destroying teachings opposed to God. By your intercession enkindle with the spirit of the holy zeal wherewith you were aflame, O all-glorious shepherd of the Church of Christ, us also, whom Christ ordained to be pastors, that with all diligence we may enlighten and confirm in the right Faith the reason-endowed flock of Christ. Prayer 2

O great and all-holy hierarch, father Basil, all-glorious teacher of the universal Church, most diligent champion of the all-holy Trinity, chosen confessor of the Mother of God and her all-immaculate virginity, all-holy model of purity, humility, and patience! Lo! I, who am greatly sinful and unworthy to gaze upon the heights of heaven, do humbly beseech you, O all-wise teacher of the Church of Christ: teach me to lead a life without fear, that I may never stray or be drawn from the path contrary to the

commandments of God; by your most mighty intercession preserve and deliver me from the temptations of the world and the snares of the devil, as you delivered there from the youth who had apostatized from our Savior most sweet, and fallen under the power of satan; grant me the strength of soul to be a diligent imitator of your exalted virtues; make me firm and unshakable in the right Faith, strengthen me, who am lacking in patience and trust in the Lord; make my heart fervent with true love for Christ, that I may desire the good things of heaven more than all else and take delight therein; and beseech the Lord to grant me contrition and fulfillment of the commandments of Christ. And when the time of my end draws near, do, O all-good father, with the All-Blessed Virgin Mary, then hasten to my aid, to defend me from the malicious assaults of the enemy; and vouchsafe that I may be an inheritor of the mansions of paradise; that with you and all the saints I may stand before the throne of the unapproachable majesty of God and glorify and hymn the life-creating, consubstantial and indivisible Trinity, always, time without end. **Amen.**

Prayer 3

O great, all-glorious and holy hierarch of Christ, divinely wise teacher of the whole Church Universal, steadfast confessor and champion of Orthodoxy, most blessed father Basil! Look down from the heights of heaven upon us, who humbly fall down before you, and entreat the Lord Almighty, Whose faithful servant you were on earth, that He grant us to keep the Faith steadfastly and without change, obedience to the Holy Church, correction for our life, speedy help amid all needs, sorrows and temptations, patience and strength.
