Kontakion I

Ikos 1

As a child who had done nothing that was vile you were shown to be a radiant angel on earth, O Gabriel; wherefore, Christ taking you from the earth opened unto you the gates of heaven, numbering you among the elect, with whom you unceasingly praise the all-holy Trinity. Therefore, you hear us on earth chanting to you such things as these:

Rejoice, fragrant vessel of angelic purity.

Rejoice, all wondrous scion of your pious parents, Peter and Anastasia.

Rejoice, adornment of children;

Rejoice, ornament of the innocent!

Rejoice, for your life was sinless;

Rejoice, for your death was precious in the sight of the Lord!

Rejoice, you who loving the cross of Christ in your childhood did bear it.

Rejoice, you who have been vouchsafed to behold the inevitable glory of God in heaven!

Rejoice, O Gabriel, martyr of Christ and child most pure.

Kontakion II

Seeing the constant rebellion of hard-hearted men against Him, Christ called you, a little child, O Gabriel, to be a right victorious warrior of heaven. Thus, with the streams of your most pure blood you cut down the ungodliness of those who fought against God and put them to shame, thus seeing the mighty works of God and the mighty works wrought in our church by you, we may majestically chant unto God who is glorified in Trinity: **Alleluia.** (**People sing Alleluia!**)

Ikos II

Possessed of a mind rendered sick by the slaying of Christ, your tormentor seized you by deception when your parents were away from the house for a little while, O Gabriel; and he took you away to the city of Bialystok, ravening to slake his thirst on your pure blood like a rabid beast. And when you did lie drained of blood and dead, the tormentors dragged your body out to a field of green wheat near the village, and like beasts cast you away. Wherefore, marveling at such a feat in your suffering, we cry to you:

Rejoice, meek victim of those who murdered in secret;

Rejoice, you endured terrible tortures!

Rejoice, you showed forth in yourself the sufferings of Christ;

Rejoice, you were sent by the Lord to reprove errors!

Rejoice, confirmation of the Faith;

Rejoice, inextinguishable beacon of the Church!

Rejoice, for you have been numbered among the choirs of the martyrs;

Rejoice, by your torments the heavenly Father has been glorified!

Rejoice, O Gabriel, martyr of Christ and child most pure!

Kontakion III

Stretched out upon the cross, yet strengthened by the power of the Most High, O most pure martyr, you found rest in the tabernacle of heaven, having rebuked those who bestially shed your blood and wounded their outrageous ungodliness. Rejoice, O you who with all the passion-bearers chant to God the hymn of victory: **Alleluia.**

(People sing Alleluia!)

Ikos III

Having the skies as a shelter and the green meadow as a bed of rest, O godly child, you laid three days without burial, unknown to all. Flocks of carrion fowl, and with them a multitude of ravenous dogs, surrounded your immaculate body, yet dared not touch it; for wise dogs stood guard over your body to fend off the birds of prey. Kontakion IV

Rejoice, you who have made your abode in the eternal kingdom! Rejoice, your untimely demise troubled the inmost parts of your

parents;

Rejoice, for their sorrow was transformed into great joy! Rejoice, for you showed yourself to the Master as one righteous; Rejoice, emulator of the sufferings of Christ!

Kontakion V

Ikos V

Seeing the angelic purity of your heart, the meekness and innocence wherein you reposed as a martyr, O Gabriel, God glorified you among His saints; for He truly showed forth an all-glorious miracle: after 30 years your body was found to be incorrupt, disclosing a fountain of healings for all who have recourse to you with faith. Wherefore, accept from us this praise:

Rejoice, receptacle of grace;

Rejoice, you have filled us with the greatest joy in the incorruption of your relics!

Rejoice, wellspring of wondrous healings;

Rejoice, for the Lord of hosts revealed wondrous things in you!

Kontakion VI

Rejoice, for Him you are glorified in heaven!

Rejoice, honored glory of the Orthodox;

Rejoice, for through you the Lord has visited our land!

Kontakion VIII

A strange and all-glorious sign of the good pleasure of God is in you apparent to all who have recourse to you, O Gabriel; for by the grace given you, you persevered from all perils those who petition you with faith, free them from tribulations, and fulfill their every request which is made with faith, teaching them to chant unto God who is Wondrous in His miracles: Alleluia. (People sing Alleluia!)

Ikos VIII

Covered with wounds, stabbed, cut and drained of your blood, O Gabriel, you surrendered your righteous soul into the hands of God, finding rest from your sufferings, having had no share in the evils of life and the griefs of earth. And pondering this righteous repose in God, with compunction we offer you these words:

Rejoice, you were innocent in your repose;

Rejoice, you whom the angels bore aloft to the bosom of Abraham;

Rejoice, you with glory attained unto the mansions of paradise;

Rejoice, you are crowned by the Lord with the crowns of immortality!

Rejoice, good follower of Christ God;

Rejoice, for the inheritance of your childhood is the kingdom of heaven!

Rejoice, for your memory is most sweet to all the faithful;

Rejoice, for your commemoration shall be from generation to generation!

Kontakion IX
